

Sculptra is a non-surgical cosmetic treatment for reducing facial lines and wrinkles and creating a fuller, more youthful appearance to your face. Also known as the "liquid facelift," Sculptra works by stimulating your body to produce new collagen and underlying tissue. Your own collagen fills in the lines and wrinkles and also elevates sagging skin.

Sculptra achieves excellent results in treating all parts of the face including the areas around the eyes and lips, and throughout the cheeks and neck. It adds volume to the cheeks, to the folds around the chin, and to the hollow areas around the eyes.

Sculptra is a safe FDA approved synthetic material that is injected below the surface of the skin directly into the areas of the face that appear sunken or hollow. Unlike many of the injectable facial fillers, the results achieved with Sculptra can last 2 years or more because it causes the body to stimulate its own collagen. Of course results may vary among individuals.

When will I see results with Sculptra™?

Sculptra provides a gradual and significant increase in skin thickness, improving the appearance of folds, indentations, and sunken areas in the face and neck. The results achieved by Sculptra are natural looking and appear gradually over a few weeks time. Because Sculptra stimulates the body to produce its own collagen, the results can last up to 2 years and longer in some cases.

The day of your Sculptra™ Treatment

No anesthesia is required for your Sculptra treatment. Numbing solution is mixed in with Sculptra to make the patient more comfortable. The doctor uses an ultra fine needle to inject Sculptra into those areas of your face and neck that appear sunken or hollow. The entire procedures take about 20-30 minutes. No recovery time is needed; you may resume normal activity immediately.

What are the possible side effects with Sculptra™?

The most common side effect with the use of Sculptra includes injection-related side effects at the site of the injection such as bleeding, tenderness, redness, bruising, or swelling. These side effects generally last on average 3-7 days.

Rarely, a possible delayed side effect with Sculptra can be small bumps about the size of a grain of sand under the skin in the treated area. These small bumps are usually not visible, and you may notice them only when you press on the treated skin. The Bumps are easily treated and occasionally go away on their own.

Who should not use Sculptra™?

You should not use Sculptra if you are allergic to any ingredient of Sculptra. Sculptra should not be injected while you have an active skin infection or inflammation in the treatment area.

How long will results last?

Results will differ for each person. In a clinical study, treatment results lasted 2 years after the first treatment session. Patients will not need a series of treatments again to maintain results. Only one touch up treatment every 2-3 years may be needed to maintain results.

Be Patient! Your best results are seen 3 months after your last treatment.
